- Interest to WHS professionals.
- The knowledge displayed in the abstract.
- New Information that will be shared with delegates.

Following the review period all abstracts will be notified via email as to the status of their abstract.



Guidelines

Abstracts must meet the following guidelines to be considered:

- Abstracts must be submitted in English
- Submitted in Word or PDF
- Should be in Arial 12 size font
- The abstract should be no more than 500 words
- The abstract document should include the following:
 - o Title of proposed presentation
 - Short Synopsis of the presentation (30 words)
 - Abstract of proposed presentation with careful consideration of how it will provide practical solutions to issues faced by work, health and safety professionals.
 - o Full name, job title and organisation of proposed presenter/s
 - Headshot photograph of proposed presenter/s (jpeg hi-res, min 300dpi)
 - o Bio of proposed presenter/s
- Presentations will be made in English
- Presentations at the National Safety Conference will be for 25 minutes, this allows a one-minute introduction by the chair and four minutes for wrap up and Q&A
